(1) The project proponents should submit the Form-1, Pre-feasibility report for TOR along with other requisite documents, Environment Impact Assessment Report, public hearing report, queries subsequently raised by the Ministry, if anyincluding details of the court matters/Orders of the Court pertaining to the project if any, in original, duly signed by the company authorized signatory for Environmental Clearance, well in advance before meeting to Ministryâ€<sup>™</sup>s project section or utmost at the time of presentation, without which the proposal will not be considered.

## Note:Submit a copy of each of above documents - <u>Hard and Soft Copies (CD)</u> to the Member secretary, Violation (Note: Not by Name) by speed post so as to reach well in time.

(ii) Compliance Report from Regional Office, MoEF&CC (Applicable for projects already having EC).
